What Is The Medical Cannabis

Cultivation and Commerce Ordinance?

The Medical Cannabis Cultivation and Commerce Ordinance is a proposed zoning ordinance regarding commercial cannabis cultivation in Calaveras County. The county is currently reviewing comments on the draft environmental impact report for the ordinance. The ordinance must answer the following questions:

- ✓ Will commercial cannabis grows be banned in their entirety? If not:
- ✓ WHO can operate a commercial grow?
- ✓ WHAT can be done (i.e. growing, processing, distributing) in particular zones within Calaveras County?
- ✓ WHERE are operations allowed (i.e. different zones in the County)?
- ✓ WHEN are activities that could have strong adverse effects allowed?
- ✓ HOW (under what circumstances) are operations allowed?
- HOW MANY grows can be effectively managed with County resources?
 HOW MUCH would permit registration cost?
- The Community Action Project encourages all people affected by this decision to work with the Planning

The Community Action Project encourages all people affected by this decision to work with the Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors to draft a clear, effective, and legally sufficient ordinance that will meet the needs of each community.
